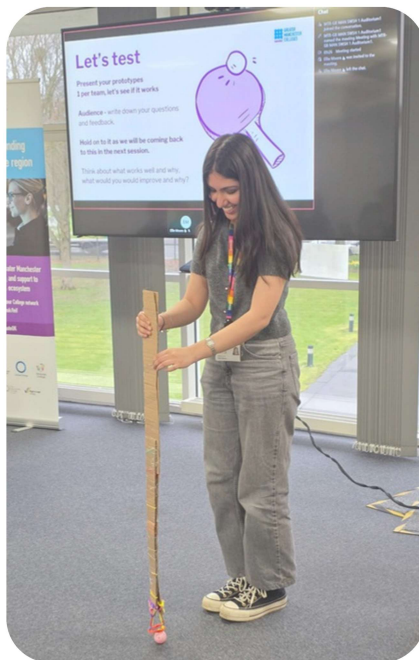


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A structured two-day, in-person programme taking participants through the full innovation journey

1 Foundations of Innovation

What innovation means at work; where ideas come from; brainstorming and using AI as an ideation tool

2 Prototyping & Problem Solving

Creative problem-solving in practice; physical prototyping; testing and iteration

3 Strategic Thinking & Proposal Development

Evidence gathering; risk and opportunity analysis; PESTLE; building a structured proposal

4 Communication & Culture of Innovation

Storytelling; pitching to stakeholders; psychological safety; sustaining an innovation culture
